Human geography	Where a human has interacted with the environment – buildings, cars, litter.	
Physical geography	Natural features of an area such as rivers, mountains, as well as climate.	
Village	Houses and buildings in a rural area.	
Town	A place with lots of houses, and shops but not as big as a city.	
Suburb	An area on the outskirts of a city.	
Key questions: Where do we live? Can you locate Leeds on a map? Which country do we live in? What city and suburb do you live in? What is human and physical geography?
