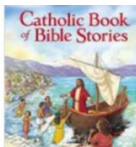

Retrieval	New Learning
- God created the world and everything in it. - God made each one of us different and special. - Creation shows the love God has for us. - We enter Gods family through Baptism.	- Be introduced to the story of Creation in Genesis 1 and be able to retell this story in any form. - Recognise that the Church teaches that all that is comes from God, our Father, who made heaven and Earth. - Recognise that though people cannot see God, they can sense his presence through the awe and wonder experienced in the beauty and order of Creation. (2 lessons). - Reflect on different ways to pray. - Recognise that prayer is a way of drawing closer to God.
